Her stories help you find strength, encourage you to **look up** to experience God's Holiness, to **look forward** through humanity's eyes to live in His Righteousness, and she challenges you to walk alongside in deeper fellowship with Christ, that you might understand the intents and purposes of God in your own life.

The compassion felt by her prophetic prose and honest humor gives those suffering from depression, a hope they might not otherwise find. Cynthia's ability to put you in the cup of the Father's Hand, is unique and forthright, and is displayed in the Loving Admonition God The Father extends to His Children in the form of His Mercy and Grace. Clear wisdom in the age of a Matthew 24 church, she gives believers a strong warning to study the Word of God for themselves, lest they become deceived by seducing spirits. Cynthia's word pictures speak a thousand words and create an indelible impression not soon forgotten.
